NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Directors of Brickyard Metropolitan District Nos. 1, 2, and 3 (“District No. 1”, District No. 2”, “District No. 3”, and collectively the “Districts”), Town of Castle Rock, Douglas County, Colorado, will meet in special session on Monday, May 4, 2026, at 11:30 a.m. at Castle Rock Library, 100 S. Wilcox Street, Room 134, Castle Rock, Colorado 80104, and via video/teleconference.

At this meeting, it is anticipated that the Board of Directors of District No. 1 (“District No. 1 Board”) will make a final determination to issue general obligation indebtedness. Specifically, the District No. 1 Board intends to consider adoption of a resolution authorizing the issuance of the District No. 1 Subordinate General Obligation Limited Tax and Special Revenue Bonds, Series 2026 (the “Series 2026 Bonds”), in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$22,000,000, for the purpose of paying, reimbursing and financing certain public improvements for the Districts and paying the costs incidental to the issuance of the Series 2026 Bonds; and, in connection therewith, approving an Indenture of Trust to be entered into by District No. 1 with BOKF, N.A. as Trustee thereunder (the “Trustee”) with respect to the Series 2026 Bonds; and other related documents and instruments (collectively, the “Financing Documents”); authorizing the execution and delivery of the Financing Documents and performance by District No. 1 under the Financing Documents; approving, ratifying and confirming other actions; making determinations and findings as to other matters related to such financing; authorizing incidental action; and repealing prior inconsistent actions.

The Boards will also take up such other business as may be before the Boards. The meeting is open to the public, and members of the public are encouraged to participate.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Supplemental Public Securities Act, no legal or equitable action brought with respect to any legislative acts or proceedings in connection with the authorization or issuance of such obligation may be commenced more than thirty days after the authorization of such obligation pursuant to the aforementioned resolution; and one or more members of the Board may participate in this meeting and may vote on the foregoing matters through the use of a conference telephone or other telecommunications device.
